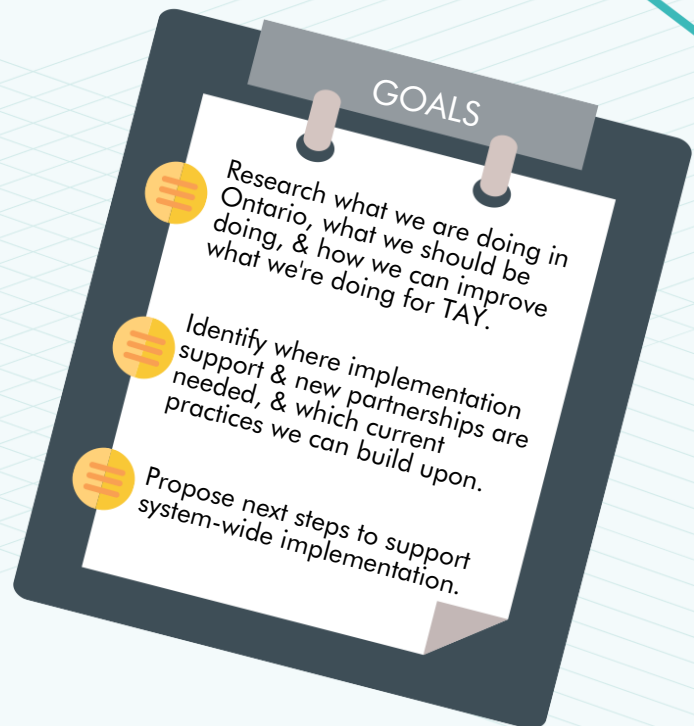


TAY in the mental health & addiction system
