## Context

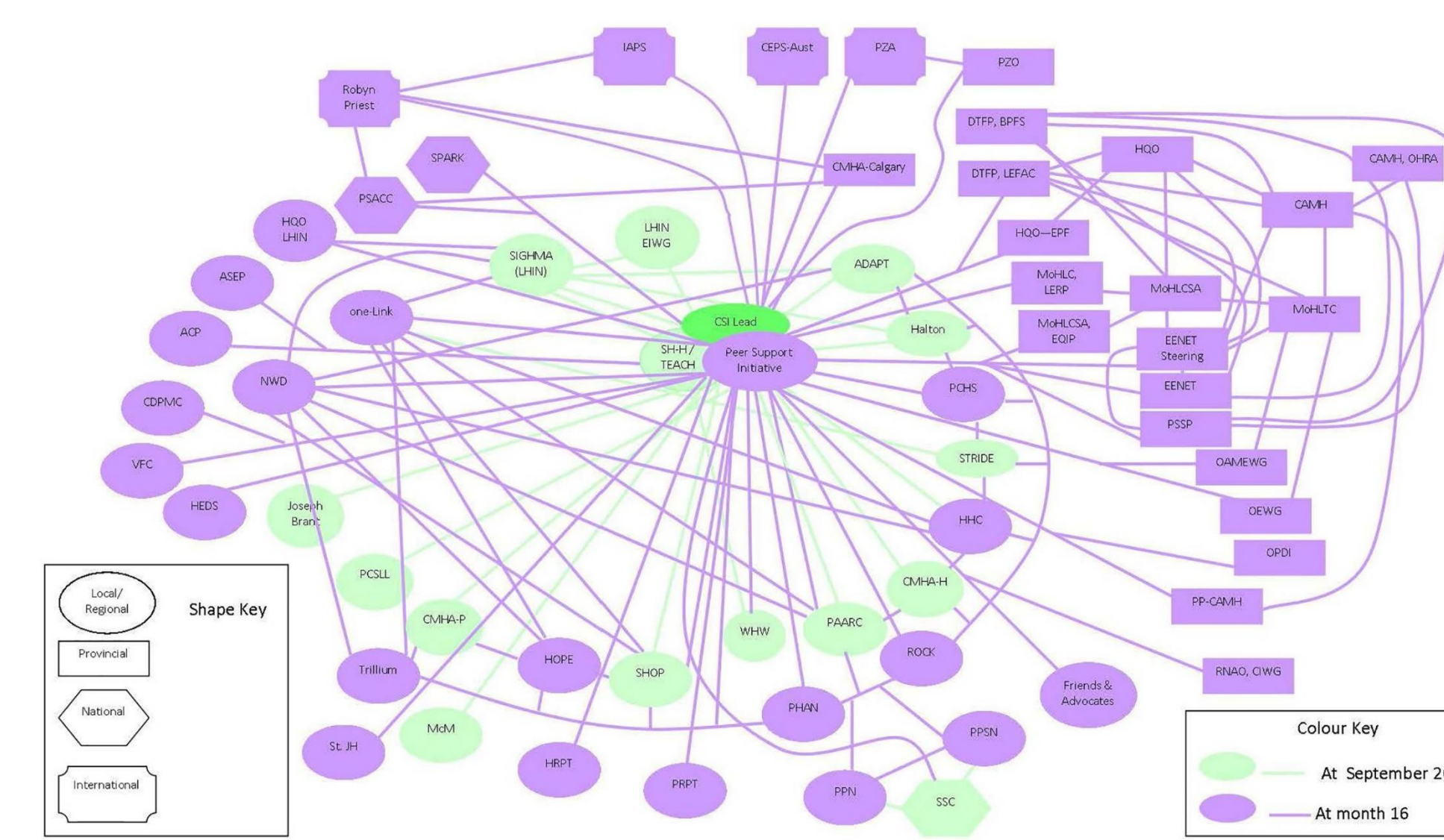
