
Youth Opioid Use in Guelph & Wellington County




Who participated in the research?

Recommendations for Action



Include youth in addressing youth substance use issues



Expand the scope of existing intiatives in the community that address the needs of at-risk youth



Engage key community stakeholders to take action on youth use of opioids and other prescription substances



Increase resiliency programming for children, youth, and families in Guelph and Wellington County



Create barrier-free harm reduction and treatment programming for youth who use substances



Work with local pharmacies to increase safe storage of prescription drugs, especially opioids
