

OVERVIEW

This interactive presentation provides an overview of two digital mental health technologies:



A4i (App4Independence), a platform for supporting people with severe mental health and addiction challenges. Currently, it supports the recovery processes in psychosis, schizophrenia and (newly) opioid use disorders.



Hope By CAMH, an app for people experiencing suicidal thoughts. It provides suicide prevention information, evidence-based tools, and crisis resources.

Sean is a clinical psychologist by training and a senior scientist and the psychology division chief at CAMH. His work includes the development and testing of interventions for youth experiencing homelessness, people with severe mental illness, and the health equity implications of climate change. He has

mental health, digital health and implementation science.
